At Bass Cat your safety and the investment you have made in your boat are not taken for granted...we demand quality craftsmanship, it's a family tradition.

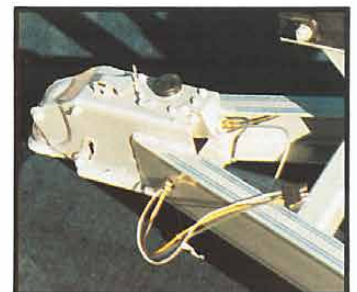

# 1988 Bass Cat Invitational

On March 5th and 6th, 1988 we held our 1988 Owners Invitational Tournament. We all met again on Lake Norfolk for this annual event. Preregistration was held at Bass Cat until 4:30 on Friday and then was transferred to the Lake Norfolk Inn on Friday evening above the pool area.

Saturday morning saw brisk, but pretty, weather as 638 fisherpersons took to the water. The day warmed up and turned out to be ideal conditions for this fun filled event. As the weigh-in closed, Big Bass for day 1 belonged to Brad DeWeese and Don Bookwalker with a 7.77 largemouth. The leaders for day 1 were Rick Norton and Jim Wakenight with 7 fish for 20.12, almost a 3 pound average!! Second place belonged to Robert Dodson and Denver Smith with 14.22 giving Rick and Jim a 5.9 lb. lead. Mark Davis and David Owens were right behind them with a 13.70 lb., 7 fish limit and third place at the end of the first day.

As the sun set, everyone scurried off to get cleaned up for the free barbecue at the fairground building. Almost all were present as we drew for prizes and held a flippin' contest. Johnnie Hawkins won the flippin' contest with Joe Verbeck finishing a close second. As the evening progressed numerous individuals and dealers were introduced to the group. The dealership awards for the 1987 model year were presented with the #1 dealer for 1987 being Eastwold Brothers Sales. The #2 dealer was Springdale Marine, and the #3 dealer for 1987 was Ozark Marine. Also, John Gowan was winding Stren line free on reels for those who brought them in. Apparently the barbecue was a success as the gang devoured 2 pigs, 1/2 beef, and 80 chickens along with all the rest of the fixin's.

Sunday brought a day much like Saturday and most thought the #1 team would repeat under similar conditions. Everything from the first day changed as the leaders were blown all the way back into 8th place and Charlie Glass and Jerry Drake produced 5 fish for 20.90 lbs. to go along with their 4 fish and 8.16 lbs. on Saturday. This gave them a total of 9 fish and 29.06 lbs. and enough to claim the first place Championship Rings, a new Sabre boat, and trailer. Second place went to J.W. Hogan and his 9 year old son, Luke Hill, who brought in 6 fish on day two and 18.67 lbs. to give them a total of 27.95 lbs. and their choice of the two Caracal Pro boats and trailers. Well, Luke chose the red one so that left Tom McBride and Mike Fisher in third place and the other Caracal Pro boat and trailer. Tom and Mike also climbed the ladder as they came into day 2 with 9.04 lbs. and ended up with a 13 fish total of 24.65 lbs. Brad and Don's fish remained Big Bass of the tournament as they took the Big Bass Championship Ring and \$1,180.00. Second Big Bass on day 1 went to Joe Patrick and R.D. Kuykendall with a 7.30 for \$885.00. Third Big Bass on day 1 was good for \$590.00 as Dan and Mary Feltman caught a 7.18 lb. largemouth. Big Bass on day 2 went to Duke Ellington and Dale Johnston with a 6.73 lb. largemouth. There were 4 other fish on day 2 over 6 lbs., although some hearts were broken as Jessie Stephens and Bob Morris took second Big Bass on day 2 with a 6.62 for \$885.00. Bob Groff and Dwight Rose took home \$590.00 for 3rd Big Bass on day 2 with a 6.32 lb. fish. A donation of \$590.00, or 10%, of the Big Bass money went to the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission and will be used in conjunction with Wallop-Brough matching funds.





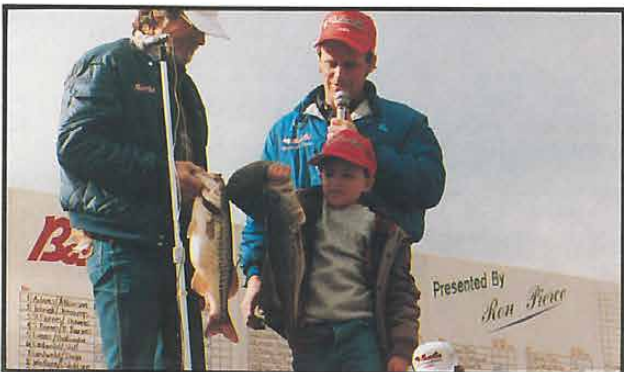
# 1988 Bass Cat Invitational

A lot of cooperation was received as Suzuki graciously donated a generator which was won by Jamie Edge of Kansas City. Mercury provided us with a service van and Jay Anderson helped keep everyone running. Galand Poe helped us out again this year with the computer. Thanks to all of these.

On the overall fish results, 871 fish were caught for a total of 1,391.28 lbs. The remarkable fact is that out of those two days of fishing all but seven (7) of those 871 fish were released alive, or over a 99% survival rate, after being kept for observation.

Overall 1988's tournament was once again a great success. Thanks go out to all of those who participated and helped to make this event what it was.

Next year's event is March 4th and 5th, 1989 and will once again be on Lake Norfolk. Come join our gang and we will see you then!!!!

## LIMITED TWO-YEAR WARRANTY

Bass Cat Boats warrants, to the original purchaser, each new boat or trailer manufactured to be free from defects in workmanship and material for a period of two (2) years under normal conditions of recommended use.

To validate this warranty, the boat registration card must be returned to Bass Cat Boats within fifteen (15) days after original purchase. All boat manufacturers are required by Federal law to notify first purchasers in the event any defect is discovered "which creates a substantial risk of personal injury to the public," or any noncompliance by manufacturer. The failure of any purchaser to fill out and return the warranty registration card may make it impossible for Bass Cat Boats to give direct notice to such purchaser.

During this two-year period, any authorized warranty repairs will be made free of charge by Bass Cat Boats at their manufacturing plant in Mountain Home, Arkansas, or at their option, by an authorized Bass Cat Boats boat dealer at the dealer's store or service center. Transportation costs to the factory are the responsibility of the purchaser. All warranty repairs must be approved by Bass Cat personnel, whose decisions are final.

This warranty does not apply to (1) any boat which shall have been repaired or altered in any way so as to affect its use and operation; (2) gelcoat cracking, crazing, blistering, or discoloring; (3) windshield breakage; (4) any boat which has been subject to misuse, negligence or accident, or used for racing or commercial purposes or operated contrary to any printed instructions furnished by Bass Cat Boats; (5) upholstery damage; (6) accessories, steering systems, pumps, lights, and other equipment not manufactured by Bass Cat Boats (these are covered by the warranties (if any) of the respective manufacturers supplying these items and are not covered under this limited warranty); (7) any boat which has been overpowered according to the maximum recommended engine horsepower specified on the capacity plate affixed to the boat.

This warranty is expressly in lieu of all other warranties, express or implied, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, and in lieu of all other obligations or liabilities on the part of Bass Cat Boats, and Bass Cat Boats expressly denies on the part of any person to incur or assume for it any other liability in connection with the sale or use of its boats and trailers. Implied warranties, if any, given by valid law shall be limited to the duration of this written warranty.

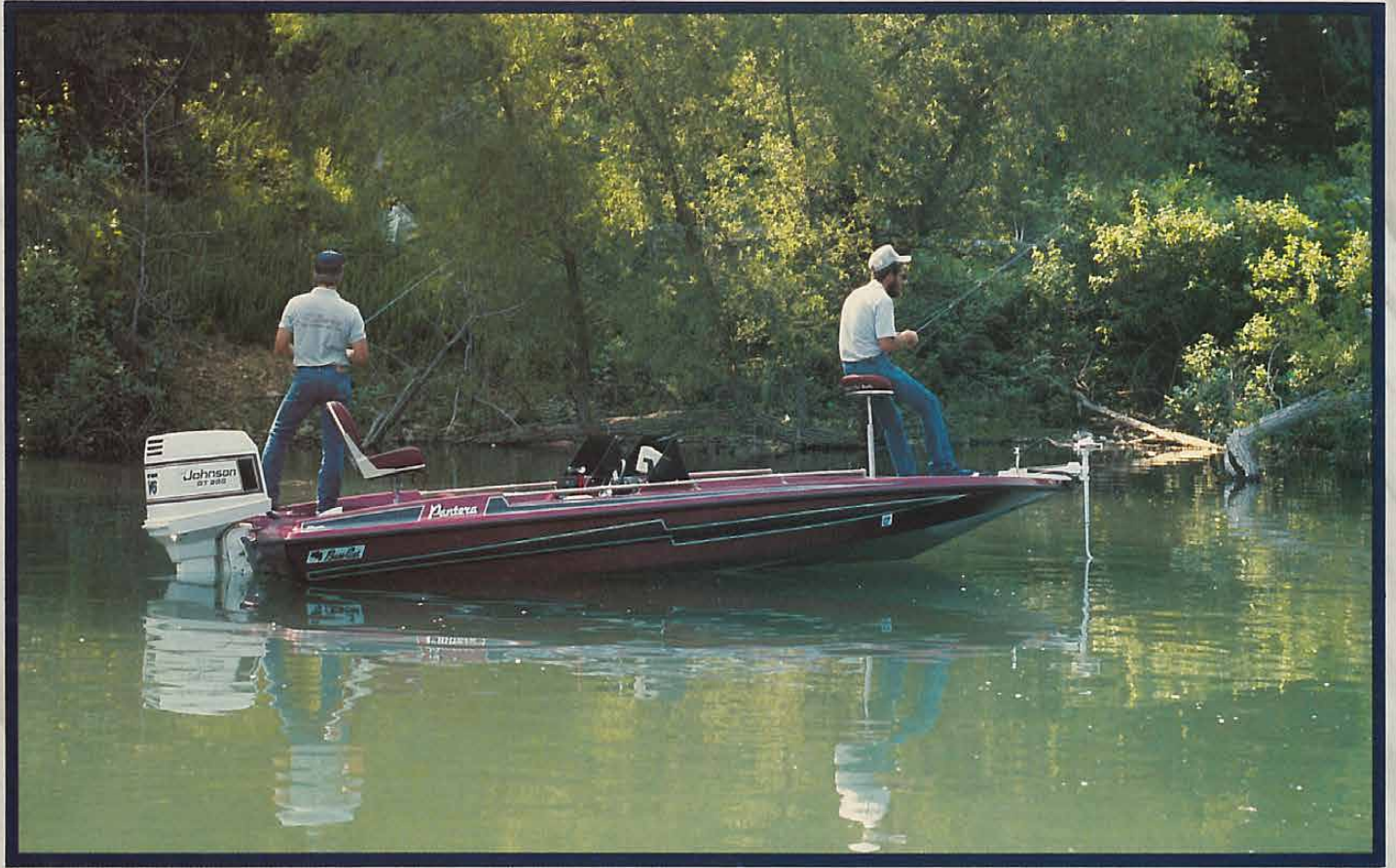
