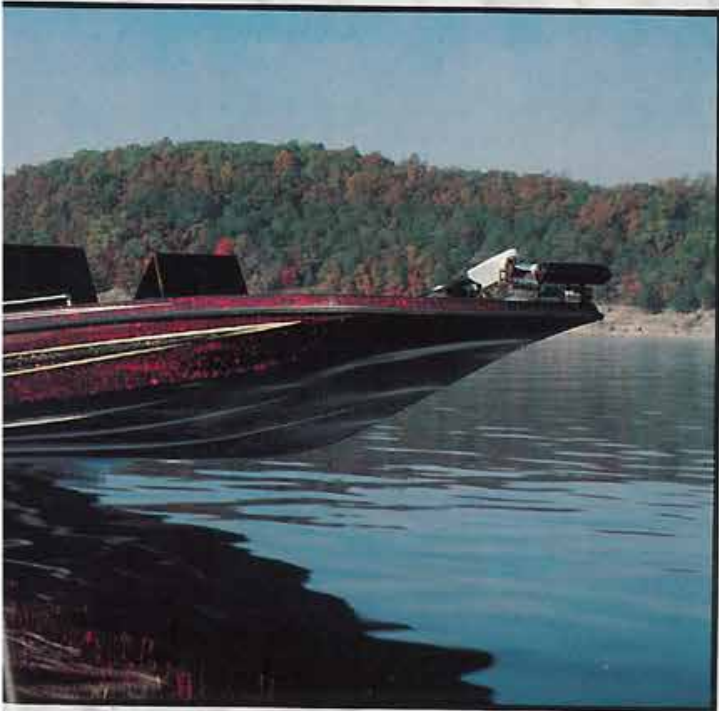

At Bass Cat your safety and the investment you have made in your boat are not taken for granted...we demand quality craftsmanship, it's a family tradition.

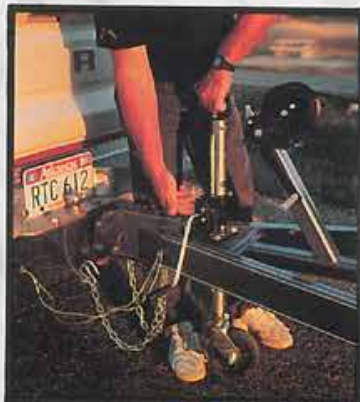
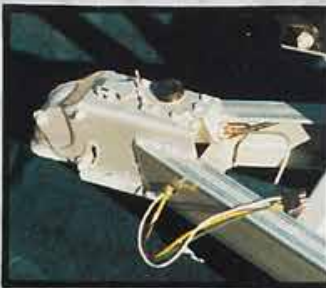

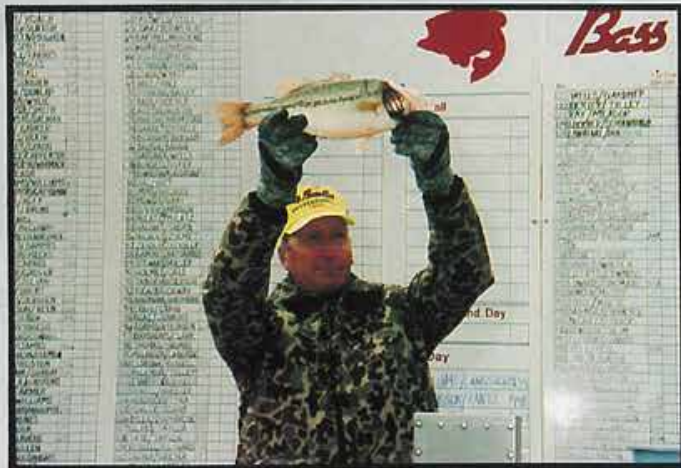


1990 Bass Cat Invitational

On March 24th and 25th, 1990, 496 boats and 992 fishermen arrived at Lake Norfolk to fish the "1990 Bass Cat Invitational." This event has always been held the first weekend in March and handicapped by the weather. In 1990 we opted for the later date to avoid this; it didn't work...the freezing rain began around takeoff time on day one. All of the anticipation for the starting takeoff got a blemish from the chill factor.

The first day saw several teams come in early; by midmorning we saw the second place team eating breakfast. They already had five fish weighing 12.73 pounds, therefore, Randy Deroven and Ron Knowles of Lake Charles, LA, thought they would fill up as they warmed up. Their livewell also held the second-largest bass of the day, the largemouth weighed in at 6.85 pounds.

The weigh-in line was shorter than expected, however, 168 teams did manage to weigh in on the first day. The leaders for the first day were Jerry Drake and Butch Carnes with their catch of seven fish which weighed 17.33 pounds. This was one of only five tournament limits, all of which were caught on the first day. The second place team enjoyed their brunch and still weighed in their 12.73 pounds. For third place was Steve Eastwold and Butch Still with another of the five limits; their seven fish weighed in at 12.49 pounds.



Big Bass, a 6.97-pound largemouth, for the day, and the tournament was caught by the team of Loyd Masterson and Kendall Keen. Loyd mastered this beauty and received the diamond recognition ring for it. This was the first year for a fish of less than seven pounds and it was only three-hundredths of a pound short.

Cash awards for the largest bass each day were \$2,480 for the first day; \$1,240 for the second day; and \$744 for the third. 10% of the total, \$992, of the big bass money was donated to the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission for projects on Lake Norfolk.

As the weigh-in ended, everyone looked forward to the evening of hot food and just heat in general. The fairgrounds building was

packed as the barbecue began. At best estimates, we served around 2400 people. This must be realistic because they ate four hogs, two wholes of beef (four halves) and 120 chickens, not to mention the food that went with it.



During the evening we drew for prizes and held contests for both kids and adults. Several people were introduced to the crowd and recognized for their various accomplishments. The pitchin' contest is always a crowd pleaser and takes center stage for most of the crowd's attention. The grand finale of the barbecue is the drawing for a Margay II and trailer. Five teams were drawn and a process of elimination was used to determine the winners; the final winning team was Ronnie LeBlanc and Robert E. Barnum of Baton Rouge, LA.

As day two began, 70% of the field was ready for takeoff; the weather had improved and was quite bearable. Even with pretty weather, several teams loaded up early with plans to leave soon after the weigh-in.

At the barbecue, the evening before, Terry Davidson ran around looking for heavy black and blue jigs in the 3/4 to 7/8 oz. range. Soon after he found some jigs, he told a few friends "We're gonna win this tournament." That is just what he and Blaine Rantz did...they brought in the largest stringer of the tournament with six fish. This wasn't even a limit but an impressive day's catch of 18.94 pounds. LIMITED FIVE-YEAR WARRANTY

Bass Cat Boats warrants, to the original purchaser, each new boat or trailer used for noncommercial uses, to be free from defects in workmanship and material for a period of two (2) years under normal conditions of recommended use, with a five (5) year hull warranty under the same conditions.

To validate this warranty, the boat registration card must be returned to Bass Cat Boats within fifteen (15) days after original purchase. All boat manufacturers are required by Federal law to notify first purchasers in the event any defect is discovered "which creates a substantial risk of personal injury to the public," or any noncompliance by manufacturer. The failure of any purchaser to fill out and return the warranty registration card may make it impossible for Bass Cat Boats to give direct notice to such purchaser.

During this two-year period, any authorized warranty repairs will be made free of charge by Bass Cat Boats at their manufacturing plant in Mountain Home, Arkansas, or at their option, by an authorized Bass Cat Boats boat dealer at the dealer's store or service center. Transportation costs to the factory are the responsibility of the purchaser. All warranty repairs must be approved by Bass Cat personnel, whose decisions are final.

This warranty does not apply to (1) any boat which shall have been repaired or altered in any way so as to affect its use and operation; (2) gelcoat cracking, crazing, blistering, or discoloring; (3) windshield breakage; (4) any boat which has been subject to misuse, negligence or accident, or used for racing or commercial purposes or operated contrary to any printed instructions furnished by Bass Cat Boats; (5) upholstery damage; (6) accessories, steering systems, pumps, lights, and other equipment not manufactured by Bass Cat Boats (these are covered by the warranties (if any) of the respective manufacturers supplying these items and are not covered under this limited warranty); (7) any boat which has been overpowered according to the maximum recommended engine horsepower specified on the capacity plate affixed to the boat.

This warranty is expressly in lieu of all other warranties, express or implied, including any implied warranty of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose, and in lieu of all other obligations or liabilities on the part of Bass Cat Boats, and Bass Cat Boats expressly denies on the part of any person to incur or assume for it any other liability in connection with the sale or use of its boats and trailers. Implied warranties, if any, given by valid law shall be limited to the duration of this written warranty.

The obligation of Bass Cat Boats, under this warranty, shall be limited to the repair or replacement of any part which is judged defective by Bass Cat Boats. Bass Cat Boats will not be liable for haul-out, launching, towing or storage charges, inconvenience or loss of time or income, or any other special or consequential damages of any kind or nature.

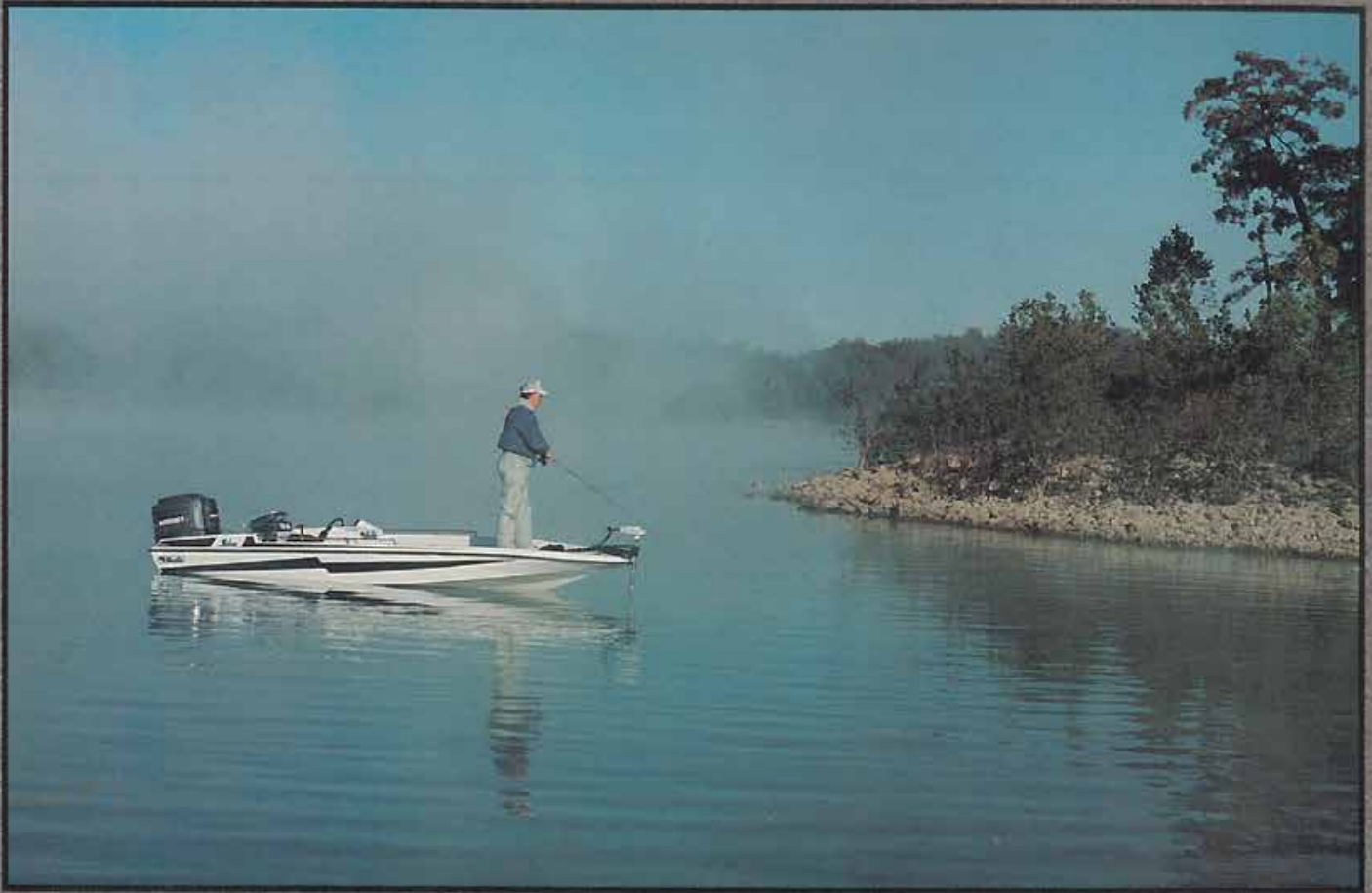

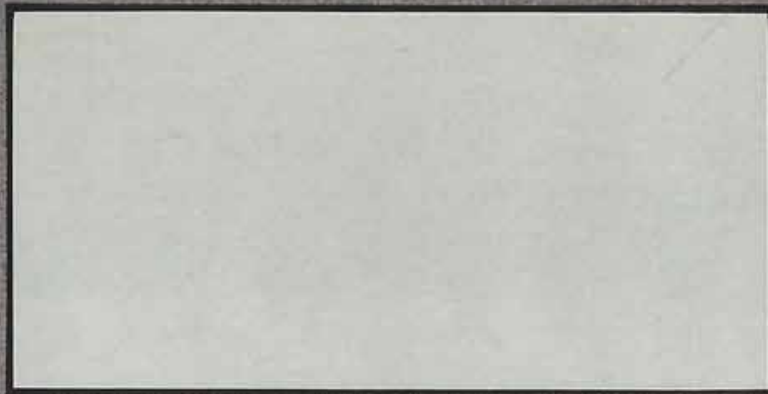
